Lighthouse Club Cambodia Relaunches with New Leadership and Expanded Industry Engagement for 2026

Lighthouse Club Cambodia has relaunched with a renewed mandate to support the construction and real estate community, outlining a refreshed leadership team and an expanded calendar of activities for 2026. The relaunch lunch, held on 14 November, marked a significant step toward rebuilding the charity's footprint in the Kingdom after several subdued operational years. The organisation aims to reinforce its dual mission of industry networking and welfare assistance for those working across Cambodia's built-environment sector.

Lighthouse Club operates globally to support individuals connected to construction, engineering and development, with a particular focus on workplace welfare, professional development and financial hardship assistance. The firefighters, seeking to control the fire as quickly as possible, called in a fleet of helicopters with very large buckets.


The buckets were dropped into the ocean for rapid filling, then flown to the forest fire and emptied.




